EQUAL EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITY FOR ALL

- NO ONE WILL BE DENIED EDUCATION BECAUSE OF INABILITY TO PAY
- NO ONE WILL HAVE TO DROP OUT OF COLLEGE BECAUSE OF FINANCIAL CONSTRAINTS

FAIR PLAY AND JUSTICE

- ADMISSION AND RECRUITMENT EXAMS WILL BE CORRUPTION-FREE
- END TO BIAS AGAINST RURAL AND NON-ENGLISH SPEAKING ASPIRANTS
- END TO DISCRIMINATION AGAINST THE MARGINALIZED (SC/ST, WOMEN ETC)
- EXTRA SUPPORT FOR THOSE WHO ARE BEHIND

CARE AND GUIDANCE

- COUNSELING AND MENTORING FOR YOUNG PEOPLE, ESPECIALLY FIRST-GENERATION AND RURAL STUDENTS SO THAT THEY DON'T MISS OPPORTUNITIES
- SUPPORT FOR STUDENTS WHO NEED HELP

SENSE OF IDENTITY AND PURPOSE

- YOUNG PEOPLE ARE VALUED AND CARE FOR BY THE SOCIETY AND GOVERNMENT
- EDUCATION WILL LEAD TO OPPORTUNITIES AND EMPLOYMENT

EQUAL EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITY



- AT EXISTING GER WITH FEE-WAIVER BASED ON INCOME
- EXPAND PUBLIC EDUCATION • FILL VACANCIES • HOSTEL AUDIT
- COST: 0.83% OF GDP, LESS THAN HALF OF 2% OF GDP COMMITMENT. WILL REQUIRE ABOUT RS 50K CRORE EXTRA FROM CENTRAL GOVT FUNDS

SUBSTANTIVE PARTICIPATION OF YOUNG INDIA IN NATION BUILDING



- BEHTAR BHARAT BRIGADE: VOLUNTEERING OPPORTUNITIES IN THE LOCAL COMMUNITY (CONVENING MEETINGS, IDENTIFYING THE NEEDS OF LOCAL PHC, SCHOOLS, HELPING PEOPLE ACCESS ENTITLEMENTS ETC). RECOGNITION FOR THOSE WHO PERFORM WELL: EXCHANGE PROGRAMS, MEETING WITH CM ETC
- 30 UNDER 30: 30% LOCAL BODY (PANCHAYAT AND MUNICIPAL) SEATS RESERVED FOR UNDER 30 YEARS. SPECIAL TRAINING/MENTORING FOR THESE YOUNG REPRESENTATIVES
- SPECIAL INCENTIVES FOR COMPANIES WHO HIRE YOUNG PEOPLE UNDER THE AGE OF 27 YEARS

FAIR PLAY AND JUSTICE



- OVERHAUL OF THE EXAMINATION SYSTEM: PLUG PAPER LEAKS IN THE ADMISSION AND RECRUITMENT PROCESS WHICH HAVE ERODED FAITH IN THE EXAMINATION SYSTEM. TIMELY AND TRANSPARENT EXAM RESULTS. A CAP ON RE-EVALUATION FEE
- STUDENTS RIGHTS COMMISSION: THERE ARE SOME NON-NEGOTIABLE RIGHTS OF A STUDENT STUDYING IN ANY COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY, SUCH AS TRANSPARENT ADMISSIONS, REGULAR CLASSES, TIMELY COMPLETION OF COURSE/DEGREE, SAFETY ON CAMPUS ETC. THESE RIGHTS HAVE BEEN DEFINED IN THE STUDENTS' RIGHTS ACT AS DRAFTED BY THE NSUI. IT IS PROPOSED THAT A STUDENTS RIGHTS COMMISSION BE CONSTITUTED TO ENFORCE PROVISIONS OF THE STUDENTS' RIGHTS ACT

CARE AND GUIDANCE



- BLOCK-LEVEL YOUTH CLUBS: AN ACCESSIBLE FRIENDLY PLACE WHERE YOUNG PEOPLE CAN GO FOR COMMUNITY, GET INFORMATION AND GUIDANCE TO MAKE INFORMED CHOICES. THE CLUB SHOULD OFFER COACHING, ENGLISH CLASSES, VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES, AN EXCHANGE PROGRAM WITH OTHER YOUTH CLUBS, AND MEETINGS WITH LEADERS IN DIFFERENT FIELDS
- SPECIAL SUPPORT FOR FIRST-GENERATION STUDENTS



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
